

SC on Governor's Delay in Bills

News

SC ruled Governors cannot indefinitely hold Bills; must act within 3 months.

Prelims Pointers

- Art. 200: assent / withhold / return once / reserve for President.
- Trap: Governor can return Money Bill X
 (Only Ordinary Bill can be returned).
- Art. 201: If reserved,
 President has no time limit to decide (trap Q).
- Trap: Governor bound by Council of Ministers advice? ✓ Yes (Art. 163, except discretionary matters).

Mains Application

Strengthens federalism; limits on <u>Governor's</u> discretion.

Women Judges Bill

News

Parliament panel recommended 33% reservation for women judges in SC/HC.

Prelims Pointers & Traps

- First woman <u>SC</u> judge = <u>Justice Fathima Beevi</u> (<u>1989</u>).
- Trap: First woman <u>HC</u> judge = <u>Justice Anna Chandy</u> (Kerala, <u>1959</u>).
- Current <u>SC</u> sanctioned strength = 34 (<u>CJI</u> + 33).
- Retirement age → SC (65), HC (62).
- Trap: NJAC Act was struck down in 2015 in Supreme Court
 Advocates-on-Record Assn. v. Union of India.

Mains Use

Gender justice + judiciary reform; <u>SDG 5</u>.

Prelims Pointers & Traps

- Published by CSO (MoSPI), not RBI (trap).
- GDP deflator = Nominal/Real GDP × 100.

- Trap: GNP ≠ GDP; GDP counts within territory, GNP =
 GDP + net income from abroad.
- Trap: Real GDP is at constant prices, Nominal at current prices.

Mains Use

Data credibility, fiscal challenges.

GST Council Stalemate



Prelims Pointers & Traps

- <u>Art. 279A</u> »→ <u>GST Council</u>, chaired by <u>Union FM</u>.
- Voting $\rightarrow \frac{75\%}{}$ weighted (Centre 33.3%, States 66.7%).
- Trap: GST introduced by 101st Amendment (not 102nd).
- Trap: Petroleum, electricity & alcohol not under GST.
- Compensation cess ended in 2022; continues only to service past loans till 2026.

Mains Use

Fiscal federalism; Centre-State revenue debates.

SCO Summit (Modi-Xi Meet)



News

First formal Modi–Xi meet since Galwan; agreed Asia's stability depends on ties.

Prelims Pointers & Traps

- SCO HQ = Beijing; founded 2001 (Shanghai).
- Members: 9 (India, Pak, China, Russia, 4 Central Asian, Iran).
- Trap: <u>SCO</u> secretariat is in <u>Moscow</u> X (It is in <u>Beijing</u>).
- Trap: <u>SCO</u> has observer states & dialogue partners, not <u>NATO-style</u>
 <u>Article 5</u> obligations.

Mains Use

Multi-alignment; India's continental strategy.

Putin's Visit Confirmed

News

Putin to attend <u>BRICS</u>+
Energy Summit in Dec 2025
despite <u>ICC</u> warrant.

ICC Details

- ICC HQ = The Hague,
 Netherlands (trap: Geneva
 X).
- India not party to Rome Statute (<u>1998</u>).

BRICS Facts

- Founded <u>2009</u>, first summit in Yekaterinburg, Russia.
- Trap: <u>BRICS</u> Development Bank = New Development Bank HQ
 Shanghai.

Mains Use

Strategic autonomy; energy security diplomacy.

Prelims Pointers & Traps

- Bhagirathi = official headstream of Ganga.
- <u>Alaknanda</u> joins at <u>Devprayag</u> → then <u>Ganga</u>.
- Trap: Yamunotri glacier feeds Yamuna (not Bhagirathi).
- <u>Cryosphere</u> = frozen water part of Earth.
- Trap: Gangotri Glacier is in Uttarakhand (not Himachal).

Mains Use

Climate change impact on Himalayan rivers.

<u>Kerala</u> 100% Digital Literacy

News

<u>Kerala</u> declared <u>fully digitally literate</u>; <u>21.8 lakh</u> trained under <u>Digi Kerala</u>.

Prelims Pointers & Traps

- <u>First e-literate panchayat</u> = Pullampara.
- **<u>Kerala</u>** leads <u>NITI SDG Index</u>.
- SDG 4 (Quality Education), SDG 9 (Innovation).
- Trap: <u>Digital India</u> launched in <u>2014</u>, not <u>2015</u>.
- Trap: Literacy rate of Kerala (2023) <u>-96%</u> (highest in India).

Mains Use

Governance innovation; bridging digital divide.



J&K Floods

Impact

- 125+ deaths
- Damaged orchards
- Srinagar–Jammu highway damaged
- Repeat of **2014** disaster

Disaster Management

- NDMA Act 2005 → NDRF,
 SDRF
- IMD alert codes: Yellow (be aware), Orange (be prepared), Red (take action)

Exam Traps

- Trap: NDRF established under MHA (Correct = under DM Act;
 MHA only provides admin)
- Trap: <u>Jhelum</u> river caused <u>2014</u> floods, not Chenab

Mains Use

Climate resilience in fragile ecosystems.



Maoist Arms Cache & Editorial Summaries

Maoist Arms Cache (Chhattisgarh)

News: 300+ arms recovered from Abujhmad forests, Narayanpur.

Prelims Pointers & Traps

- Greyhounds (AP), CoBRA (CRPF) → anti-Maoist units.
- Abujhmad = in Chhattisgarh (trap: Jharkhand \times).
- "Red Corridor" → 10 States.
- Trap: Surrender & rehabilitation policy is a State subject, not Union List.

Mains Use

Internal security case study; **Left Wing Extremism**.

- <u>130th Amendment</u> <u>Arrest ≠ Conviction</u> »→ <u>due process</u>
 (<u>GS-II</u>, <u>Essay</u>).
