
## Regional Support

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## **Supreme Court** on **Ex-CBI Officers**

## Case Background

The <u>Supreme Court</u> upheld <u>Delhi High Court's</u> order directing registration of <u>FIRs</u> against former <u>CBI officers</u> <u>Vinod Kumar Pandey</u> and <u>Neeraj Kumar</u> regarding irregularities dating back to <u>2000</u>.

### <u>Legal Framework</u>

- FIR under CrPC Section 154
- CBI operates under DSPE Act, 1946
- State consent requirements



(i) <u>Key Term</u>: <u>FIR (First Information</u>

<u>Report)</u> represents the initial step in <u>criminal investigation procedures</u>.

# Investigation Transfer Dynamics



### **Original Assignment**

Investigation initially assigned to Delhi SpecialCell for preliminary inquiry



## **Judicial Intervention**

Supreme Court orders transfer from Special

Cell to regular Delhi Police



### **Leadership Structure**

Investigation to be led by Assistant

**Commissioner of Police** rank **officer** 

The jurisdiction transfer demonstrates judicial oversight in ensuring appropriate investigation mechanisms, with ACP rank representing supervisory level in Delhi Police hierarchy, distinct from NIA operations.



## **Umar Khalid UAPA Case**

## Legal Challenge

Former JNU leader Umar Khalid approached the Supreme Court challenging Delhi High Court's denial of bail in the February 2020 riots case filed under the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act.

### **UAPA Framework**

The Unlawful Activities Prevention Act, 1967, criminalises unlawful and terrorist activities with highly restrictive bail provisions under Section 43D, making pre-trial detention common in such cases.



# Tamil Nadu Untouchability Wall Controversy



#### **Discrimination Allegations**

Dalits in Valangaiman, Tiruvarur district, allege that a 10-foot wall blocks their access to common areas, whilst police claim it's merely a property dispute rather than caste-based discrimination.

### **Legal Framework**

- Article 17 prohibits untouchability
- SC/ST Prevention of Atrocities Act applicable
- Social exclusion constitutes denial of access

Untouchability walls represent physical manifestations of caste-based social exclusion, directly violating constitutional principles and statutory protections for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.



## Social Policy & Certification

# **Manipur Caste Certificate Law**

## **Legislative Process**

The law regulating SC/OBC certificates in Manipur received Presidential assent after the Governor reserved the bill, demonstrating the constitutional process for sensitive social legislation.

## Administrative Framework

- State-level caste certificate governance
- Governor's discretionary powers
- Presidential approval for reserved bills



Constitutional Process: Governors can reserve bills for Presidential consideration, particularly for socially sensitive legislation.

Similar scrutiny mechanisms exist in <u>Maharashtra</u> and <u>Andhra Pradesh</u>, reflecting nationwide efforts to prevent <u>fraudulent caste certificate claims</u> whilst protecting <u>genuine beneficiaries' rights</u>.

# Certificate Validity Framework

#### **Presumptive Validity**

Caste certificates remain valid throughout the verification process until the scrutiny committee reaches a final decision, preventing denial of benefits during investigation periods.

#### **Beneficiary Protection**

This provision ensures that <u>legitimate beneficiaries</u>
continue receiving <u>constitutional protections</u> and
<u>reservations</u> whilst <u>verification procedures</u> are ongoing,
balancing <u>administrative efficiency</u> with <u>individual rights</u>.



Manipur's reservation structure allocates 31% for Scheduled Tribes, 17% for Other Backward Classes, and 2% for Scheduled Castes in education and employment, reflecting the state's unique demographic composition and constitutional obligations.


## **Coordinated Response**
