Vice-President Election

C.P. Radhakrishnan Elected

<u>Key Development</u>: Radhakrishnan elected as <u>Vice-President</u> with 473 out of 750 valid votes, sworn in at <u>Rashtrapati Bhavan</u>.

Article 66

VP elected by MPs only, not States

STV System

Single transferable vote used

Secret Ballot

No <u>whip</u> binding allowed



Key Terms for UPSC

- <u>Electoral College (VP)</u>: <u>MPs</u> of both <u>Houses</u> participate
- <u>STV</u>: <u>Voters</u> rank preferences; <u>votes</u> transferred until <u>quota</u> met
- <u>Cross-voting</u>: <u>Legislators</u> voting against <u>party line</u>; valid in <u>VP elections</u>

Nepal Political Crisis

Current Situation: Prime Minister Oli resigns amid widespread protests, vandalism of Parliament, and political turmoil engulfing the nation.

1950 Treaty Significance

<u>India-Nepal Treaty of Peace & Friendship</u> remains cornerstone of bilateral relations

Open Border Policy

Indo-Nepal open border allows movement without visa requirements


Gen-Z Protests: Youth-driven agitation movements

Doha Diplomatic Strikes



Latest Development: Israel strikes <u>Hamas leaders</u> in <u>Qatar</u> whilst <u>U.S.-backed truce proposal</u> remains under active discussion.


Backchannel Diplomacy

<u>Informal and secret negotiations</u> between conflicting parties

CBMs

<u>Confidence-building measures</u> designed to <u>reduce</u> <u>mistrust</u>

Key Point: **Qatar** serves as **host mediator**, not **treaty guarantor** in **peace negotiations**.



Rajasthan Anti-Conversion Bill

<u>Legislative Update</u>: New Bill passed with provisions for <u>life</u>
<u>imprisonment</u> and <u>substantial fines</u>; <u>opposition stages walkout</u> in protest.

<u>Public order</u> falls under <u>State List</u> subject matter

Conversion laws target fraud, force, and allurement

Essential Religious Practices and **Proportionality Test** apply

Essential Religious Practices: **Supreme Court** test for **Article 25** protection

<u>Proportionality Test</u>: <u>Balance fundamental rights</u> with <u>reasonable</u> <u>restrictions</u>

Assam SOP on Foreigners

Policy Shift

<u>Major Development</u>: <u>Assam</u> bypasses <u>traditional tribunals</u>, introduces new <u>Standard Operating Procedure</u> for <u>expulsion</u> of <u>illegal migrants</u>.



Assam Accord Cutoff

24 March 1971 remains the decisive date

Foreigners' Tribunals


<u>Quasi-judicial bodies</u> under <u>Foreigners Act</u>

<u>Key Terminology</u>

- Expulsion SOP: Government process for systematic deportation
- NRC: National Register of Citizens specifically for Assam

NARI Women's Safety Index

Concerning Findings: <u>Delhi</u> performs poorly in national report highlighting significant gaps in women's safety across urban India.





Understanding the Metrics

Gender Index: Comprehensive measure of empowerment and safety parameters

<u>Perception Survey</u>: Captures subjective experiences of safety in public spaces

Karnataka Protests

'<mark>Chamundi Chalo</mark>' <mark>Movement</mark>



<u>Political Tension</u>: <u>BJP</u> and <u>VHP</u> stage protests over <u>Dasara inauguration</u> <u>controversy</u>; police detain prominent leaders.

Constitutional Point: Preventive custody differs from arrest for criminal offence

Article 19(1)(b)

Right to peaceful assembly, subject to reasonable restrictions



2)

Section 144 CrPC

Prohibits assemblies for maintaining public order

<u>Legal Framework</u>: <u>Reasonable restrictions</u> balance <u>fundamental rights</u> with <u>security</u>, <u>morality</u>, and <u>public order concerns</u>.

Telangana HC on Group-I Exams

<u>Judicial Intervention</u>: <u>High Court</u> orders comprehensive re-evaluation of <u>TSPSC Mains</u> answer scripts following procedural concerns.



<u>Judicial Review</u>: <u>Courts</u> possess authority to oversee legality of <u>examination procedures</u> and ensure <u>procedural fairness</u>.

Manipur Border Fencing Protest

Ethnic Tensions: Naga Council declares embargo against India–Myanmar border fencing project, citing cultural and ethnic concerns.



FMR Policy

Free Movement Regime allows 16 km visa-free entry across border

Tribal Concerns

Ethnic communities historically split across international boundaries

Key Concepts

- Ethnic Ties: Traditional tribal communities divided by colonial-era borders
- Embargo: Economic boycott employed as form of political protest



Nepal Airport Crisis

700 Indians Stranded

<u>Travel Disruption</u>: Flight operations suspended at <u>Kathmandu airport</u>, leaving approximately <u>700 Indian citizens stranded</u> without immediate <u>evacuation options</u>.

Consular Responsibility

Ministry of External Affairs
coordinates citizen assistance

Emergency Response

<u>Diplomatic missions</u> activate <u>crisis</u> <u>management protocols</u>

Evacuation Planning

Organised <u>rescue missions</u> for <u>stranded nationals</u>

Consular Assistance: Government obligation to provide help to citizens abroad during emergencies

Siachen Avalanche Tragedy

Military Loss: Devastating avalanche claims lives of three brave soldiers on treacherous <u>Saltoro Ridge</u> in <u>Siachen sector</u>.

World's Highest Battlefield

Siachen Glacier presents extreme operational challenges

Natural Hazards

<u>Avalanches</u> pose constant threat to military personnel



Technical Terms

Avalanche: Sudden, rapid flow of snow down mountainous slopes

<u>HAA Warfare</u>: High Altitude Area military operations in extreme environmental conditions

Supreme Court on Governors

<u>Constitutional Review</u>: <u>Supreme Court</u> examines concerning delays in <u>Governor's assent</u> to <u>state legislation</u>, addressing <u>federal balance</u> issues.



Articles 200/201

<u>Constitutional provisions</u> governing <u>gubernatorial assent</u> <u>process</u>



Money Bill Exception

<u>Money Bills</u> cannot be returned by <u>Governor</u> to <u>state</u> <u>legislature</u>

Assent: Formal approval required for bills to become law

Reservation for President: Governor's power to refer controversial bills to President



<u>Aadhaar</u> in **<u>Bihar Electoral Rolls</u>**

Supreme Court Decision

Electoral Reform: Supreme Court permits use of Aadhaar for voter roll verification processes in Bihar state.

Critical Distinction: <u>Aadhaar</u> serves as <u>identity</u>
 proof, not <u>citizenship proof</u>






SIR Process

<u>Special Intensive Revision</u> involves comprehensive <u>electoral</u> <u>roll cleanup exercise</u>



BLO Role

Booth Level Officers manage and maintain accurate electoral rolls





Environmental Concern: Government seeks comprehensive report on <u>Forest Rights Act</u> claims in <u>Great Nicobar development project</u> area.

FRA 2006

Forest Rights Act mandates Gram Sabha consent for forest land use

Tribal Rights

Indigenous communities possess traditional forest access rights

Rights Categories

<u>IFR</u>: <u>Individual Forest Rights</u> for <u>traditional forest dwellers</u>

CFR: Community Forest Rights
for collective resource
management

ICMR Malaria Vaccine



Medical Breakthrough: <u>Indian Council of Medical Research</u> licenses indigenous <u>malaria vaccine</u> to five <u>pharmaceutical firms</u> for mass production.

- Malaria Parasites
 Plasmodium falciparum and vivax cause disease
- Indigenous Development

Made-in-India vaccine reduces import dependency

Key Institutions and Terms

- <u>ICMR</u>: Apex medical research body coordinating health research
- AEFI: Adverse Event Following Immunisation monitoring system

AI & Chatbots Consciousness

<u>Philosophical Debate</u>: Emerging discourse questions whether <u>advanced chatbots</u> possess <u>consciousness</u>, challenging traditional understanding of <u>artificial intelligence</u>.




Prelims Alert: Chatbots represent generative AI technology, distinct from traditional search engines

Health Alert: Reported case of rare infection caused by Naegleria fowleri, highlighting public health concerns about waterborne pathogens.

Pathogen Source

Free-living amoeba found in warm freshwater environments

Disease Mechanism

Causes Primary Amoebic Meningoencephalitis (PAM)

<u>PAM</u>: Rare but fatal <u>brain infection</u> with extremely high mortality rate

Rare Earths & China Dominance

Strategic Concern: China's overwhelming dominance in rare earth elements prompts India to seek supply-chain resilience and reduce critical mineral dependency.




