Bihar Electoral Roll Case – Supreme Court Hearing

Keywords: Electoral Transparency, Voter Rights Protection - Electoral Transparency: The principle that electoral processes must be open, accountable, and subject to public scrutiny to maintain democratic legitimacy; Voter Rights Protection: Safeguarding citizens' fundamental right to participate in democratic processes through fair and inclusive electoral systems.

Numbers Issue

Adult population: 8.22 crore; Final rolls: 7.42 crore → ~80 lakh missing voters (~10%)

SC Bench

Justice Surya Kant and Joymalya Bagchi directing EC clarification

Petition Filed

Prashant Bhushan alleging disproportionate deletion of women & minorities

Rule Cited: Rule 21A, Registration of Electors' Rules, 1960 — requires public notice of deleted names.

Constitutional Link: Article 326 — Universal Adult Suffrage; Article 324 — Election Commission powers.

SC Notice to Assam BJP & X (Social Media Case)

Context: Plea against AI-generated communal video showing "Muslim takeover" if BJP loses polls.

Bench: Justices Vikram Nath & Sandeep Mehta.

Reach: 4.6 million views, 19,000 likes, 6,100 reposts.

Grounds: Violation of secular principles & Representation of the People Act, 1951.

India–UK Relations: Starmer's India Visit

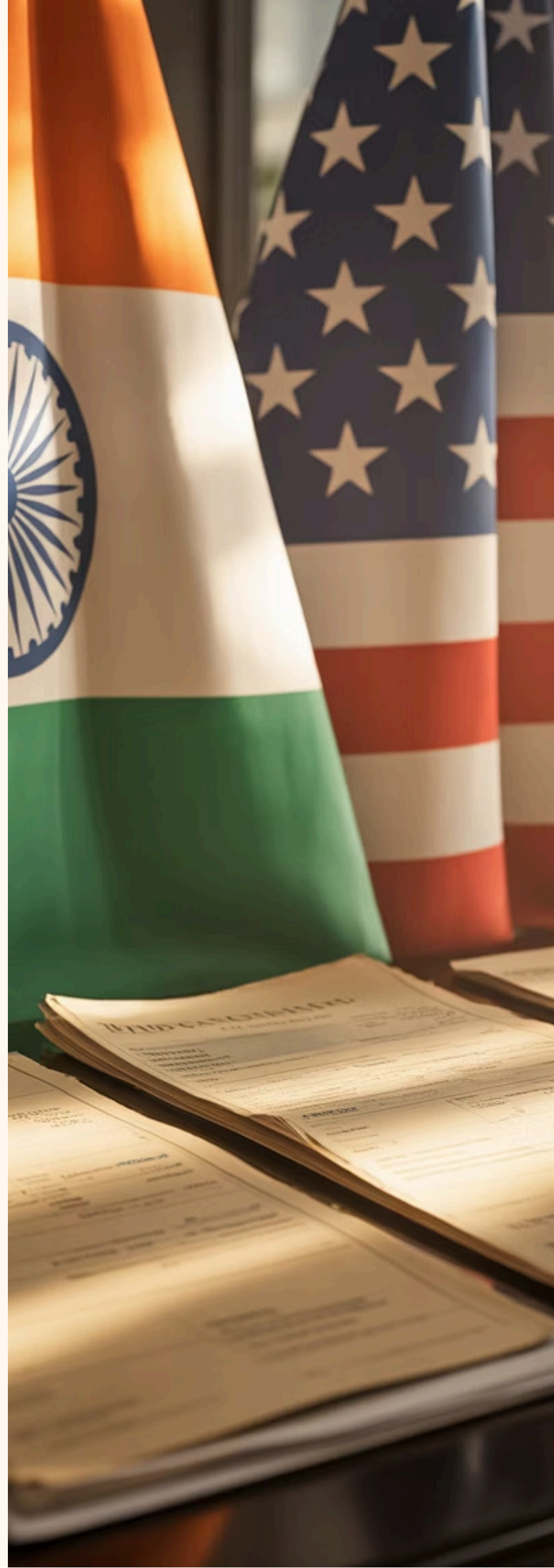
- **Leader:** UK PM Keir Starmer with 100-member business delegation.**Keywords:** Economic diplomacy, bilateral engagement - Economic diplomacy refers to using economic tools to achieve foreign policy objectives; bilateral engagement involves direct cooperation between two nations.
- **Event:** Global Fintech Fest, Mumbai (Oct 10–11).**Keywords:** Financial technology cooperation, sectoral partnership - Financial technology cooperation involves joint development of fintech solutions; sectoral partnership focuses on specific industry collaboration.
- **Objective:** Review implementation of Comprehensive Economic & Trade Agreement (CETA).**Keywords:** Trade agreement implementation, economic integration - Trade agreement implementation involves executing negotiated terms; economic integration creates deeper economic ties between nations.
- **Trade Volume:** £44.1 billion (2024–25).**Keywords:** Bilateral trade growth, economic partnership value - Bilateral trade growth measures increasing economic exchanges; economic partnership value quantifies mutual economic benefits.
- **Focus Sectors:** Fintech, education, green finance, digital trade.**Keywords:** Digital economy cooperation, sustainable finance - Digital economy cooperation involves joint digital initiatives; sustainable finance integrates environmental considerations into financial systems.

India–Afghanistan: Taliban's Muttaqi Visit

Visitor: Amir Khan Muttaqi, Taliban Foreign Minister.

Event: Moscow Format meet hosted by Russia – India participated.

Significance: Taliban admitted as "member" for first time; its flag displayed officially. Step toward de facto recognition; UNSC exemption for travel granted.



Law, Administration & Ethics

Madras HC Transfers District Judge

Keywords: **Judicial Accountability, Abuse of Authority** - **Judicial Accountability ensures judges are answerable for their actions within the legal framework; Abuse of Authority involves misuse of official power beyond legal jurisdiction.**

Officer: Pa.U. Chemmal, Kancheepuram District Judge.

Reason: Abuse of authority — remanded DSP to custody without jurisdiction.

Inquiry by: Registrar (Vigilance) confirmed misuse of power.

Action: Transferred as Chairman, Permanent Lok Adalat (Ariyalur).



Karur Stampede Case (Tamil Nadu) – SC Hearing

Context: Plea for CBI probe into Sept 27, 2025 stampede (41 deaths) at actor Vijay's rally.

Current Status: SC to hear on Oct 10, 2025.

Earlier: Madras HC refused CBI probe; SIT investigation ongoing.



Economy & Infrastructure

Keywords: Infrastructure Development, Economic Multiplier Effect - Infrastructure Development involves building physical systems that support economic activity; Economic Multiplier Effect describes how initial spending creates additional rounds of economic activity.

Cabinet Approval – Multi-Tracking Rail Projects

Keywords: Connectivity Enhancement, Logistics Efficiency - Connectivity Enhancement improves physical and economic links between regions; Logistics Efficiency reduces transportation costs and time through better infrastructure.

Keywords: Rail Network Expansion, Freight Capacity - Rail Network Expansion increases transportation infrastructure; Freight Capacity enhances goods movement efficiency.

Investment in rail infrastructure

Keywords: Capital Investment, Infrastructure Financing - Capital Investment involves long-term spending on productive assets; Infrastructure Financing provides funding for public infrastructure projects.

Maharashtra ₹31,628-crore Relief for Farmers

Keywords: Agricultural Risk Management, Disaster Compensation - Agricultural Risk Management involves strategies to protect farmers from production and income risks; Disaster Compensation provides financial relief for losses due to natural calamities.

- **Purpose:** Flood & heavy rain damage relief
- **Dry land:** ₹18,500/ha

Environment, Science & Technology

Elephant Conflict Study – Karnataka & Kerala

Keywords: **Human-Wildlife Conflict**, **Conservation Biology** - Human-Wildlife Conflict occurs when wildlife requirements overlap with human activities, leading to costs for both; Conservation Biology applies scientific principles to protect biodiversity and ecosystem integrity.

Report by: Centre for Wildlife Studies (CWS)

Comprehensive analysis of elephant-human interactions

Keywords: **Ecological Research**, **Wildlife Behavior Analysis** - Ecological Research studies relationships between organisms and their environment; Wildlife Behavior Analysis examines animal responses to environmental changes and human activities.

Key Finding: 38% injuries/deaths in Kerala from infrastructure

Trenches, solar, electric fences cause most elephant casualties

Keywords: **Anthropogenic Barriers**, **Wildlife Corridor Fragmentation** - Anthropogenic Barriers are human-made obstacles that impede wildlife movement; Wildlife Corridor Fragmentation breaks up natural pathways animals use for migration and foraging.

Additional Findings:

- **Rainfall:** Top driver (28%) of human–elephant conflict mitigation choices
- **Cultural Factor:** Communities show empathy → link to cultural reverence for Ganesha

Physics Nobel Prize 2025

Winners: John Clarke, Michel Devoret, John Martinis.

Work: Created circuit demonstrating quantum tunnelling using Josephson junctions.

Significance: Foundation for quantum computing technology.

Keywords: **Quantum Physics Applications**, **Superconductivity Research** - Quantum Physics Applications involve practical uses of quantum mechanical principles; Superconductivity Research studies materials with zero electrical resistance.

Ladakh Violence Update

Personnel Deployment

Deployed: 1,500 CRPF troops.

Context: Managing law and order situation following protests.

Keywords: Internal Security Management, Paramilitary Deployment - Internal Security Management involves maintaining law and order within national boundaries; Paramilitary Deployment uses semi-military forces for internal security operations.

Casualty Assessment

Casualties: 4 dead, 150 injured (Sept 24 protests).

Denial: CRPF refuted pellet gun use; only tear gas deployed.

Keywords: Crowd Control Protocols, Use of Force

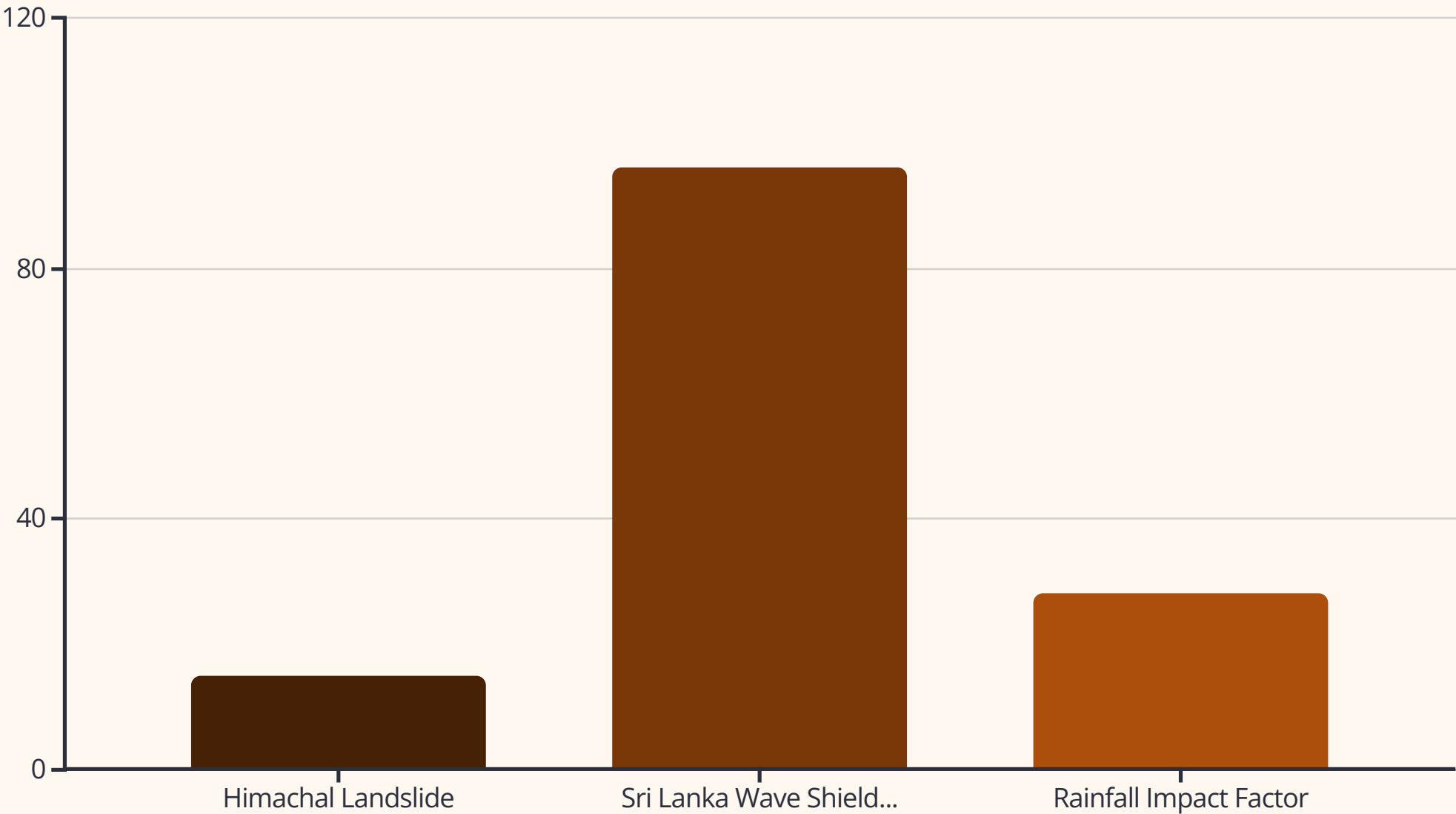
Guidelines - Crowd Control Protocols are standardized procedures for managing large gatherings; Use of Force Guidelines govern when and how security forces can employ force.



Disasters & Climate Events

Natural Disasters & Response

Keywords: Disaster Risk Reduction, Emergency Response Systems -
Disaster Risk Reduction involves systematic efforts to analyze and reduce disaster vulnerabilities.
Emergency Response Systems are coordinated mechanisms for immediate disaster response and relief.



Himachal Landslide – Bilaspur District

Casualties: 15 dead; bus hit by falling boulders (Oct 8).

Relief: ₹1 lakh PMNRF + ₹50,000 for injured.

Cause: Heavy rain since Oct 6.

Keywords: Slope Stability, Himalayan Vulnerability -
Slope Stability refers to the resistance of inclined surfaces to failure by sliding or collapsing.
Himalayan Vulnerability describes the mountain region's susceptibility to climate-induced disasters.

Sri Lanka's Geographic Role in Wave Protection

Study by: INCOIS (Hyderabad).

Finding: Sri Lanka acts as natural shield protecting India's SE coast from Southern Ocean swell waves.

Data: 96% of long-period swells blocked by Sri Lankan landmass.

PM Modi–Putin Phone Call

Occasion: Putin's 73rd birthday.

Context: Discussion on upcoming India–Russia Summit (Dec 2025); Arctic cooperation.

Keywords: Strategic Partnership, Arctic Diplomacy - Strategic Partnership: long-term cooperative relationship between nations based on shared interests; Arctic Diplomacy: international relations and cooperation in the Arctic region, increasingly important due to climate change and resource access.



INCOIS Wave Study

Research: Sri Lanka's role as natural wave barrier.

Implication: Coastal hazard models must include natural barriers amid climate change.

Data Source: Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services.

Keywords: Coastal Geography, Disaster Preparedness - Coastal Geography: study of the dynamic interface between ocean and land; Disaster Preparedness: advance planning and preparation to effectively respond to emergency situations.



Quantum Computing Recognition

Achievement: Physics Nobel for quantum tunnelling research.

Scientists: Clarke, Devoret, Martinis.

Impact: Foundation technology for quantum computing advancement.

Keywords: Quantum Technology, Scientific Innovation - Quantum Technology: applications based on quantum mechanical phenomena; Scientific Innovation: the development of new technologies and methods through research and experimentation.

Key Institutional Updates

Keywords: Institutional Governance, Administrative Efficiency - Institutional Governance: systems and processes that guide institutional decision-making and accountability; Administrative Efficiency: the ability to achieve maximum output with minimum wasted effort or expense in government operations.

- **Election Commission:** Clarifying Bihar voter roll discrepancies under SC direction
- **High Court Action:** Madras HC demonstrates judicial accountability through district judge transfer
