Keywords: **Air Power Doctrine**, **Indigenous Defence Capability** - **Air Power Doctrine**: Strategic framework governing the employment of air forces to achieve national objectives through air superiority, precision strikes, and deterrence; **Indigenous Defence Capability**: National capacity to develop, manufacture, and sustain defence equipment domestically, reducing dependency on foreign suppliers and enhancing strategic autonomy.

Kishtwar-Kokernag Snowstorm Incident (J&K)

Keywords: Counter-Insurgency Operations, Mountain Warfare -

Counter-Insurgency Operations: Military operations designed to defeat insurgent movements through coordinated intelligence, security, and developmental activities; **Mountain Warfare:** Specialized military operations conducted in high-altitude terrain requiring adapted tactics, equipment, and training for extreme weather conditions.


- **Event Date:** Night of Oct 6–7, 2025.
- **Incident:** Two Para Commando soldiers missing during anti-terror operation in Chenab Valley.
- **Cause:** Snowstorm, "white-out" conditions in high-altitude terrain.
- **Status:** Search operations hampered by weather.
- **Context:** Ongoing counter-insurgency operations in J&K's difficult terrain.

Operational Significance: Operation Sindoor (May 7-10, 2025) - First major cross-border strike post-Balakot (2019).

Keywords: Cross-Border Strikes, Surgical Strikes Doctrine - Cross-Border

Strikes: Military operations conducted across international borders to target specific threats while maintaining strategic restraint; **Surgical Strikes**

Doctrine: Precision military operations designed to achieve specific objectives with minimal collateral damage and escalation risk.

Gaza Conflict – 2 Years Since Oct 7, 2023

Keywords: Humanitarian Crisis, International Law - **Humanitarian Crisis:** Situation where civilian population faces threats to life, health, safety, or well-being due to conflict, requiring international assistance; **International Law:** Body of legal principles governing relations between states and international organizations, including laws of war and human rights.

Current Status

Casualties: ~65,000 Palestinians killed since the start of the conflict.

Duration: Two years since October 7, 2023 attacks.

Documentation: Books and testimonies document conditions in Gaza.

Cultural Resistance

Symbol: Refaat Alareer's poem "If I Must Die" became symbol of Palestinian resistance.

Context: Poet killed in Israeli airstrike, work inspired by Emily Dickinson.

Significance: Literature as soft power during conflict.

UPSC Relevance: West Asia crisis, UNGA & ICJ role in Gaza, violations of international humanitarian law.

Keywords: UNGA Resolutions, ICJ Proceedings - **UNGA Resolutions:** Non-binding declarations by UN General Assembly reflecting international opinion on global issues; **ICJ Proceedings:** International Court of Justice cases addressing disputes between states and advisory opinions on legal questions.

Strategic Operations Analysis

Operation Sindoor (Detailed Assessment)

Keywords: Cross-Border Counter-Terrorism, Strategic Deterrence - Cross-Border Counter-Terrorism: Military operations conducted across international boundaries to neutralize terrorist infrastructure and capabilities; Strategic Deterrence: Military doctrine aimed at preventing adversary actions through demonstration of capability and resolve.

Operational Details

Targets: JeM headquarters Bahawalpur, LeT headquarters Muridke, multiple terror camps in Pakistan-administered Kashmir

Weapons Used: BrahMos missiles, Akashteer air defense units, loitering munitions - all indigenous systems

Strategic Impact: Marked significant strategic turning point, demonstrated military advantage over Chinese-supported opponent

Constitutional Framework: Article 355 - Union's duty to protect states against external aggression.

Keywords: Literature as Soft Power, Cultural Resistance - Literature as Soft Power: Use of creative works to influence international opinion, preserve cultural identity, and convey political messages; Cultural Resistance: Forms of non-violent opposition that preserve identity and values through artistic expression during conflicts.

Impact: Became symbol of Palestinian resistance after poet's death in Israeli airstrike

Literary Significance: Cross-cultural poetic dialogue transcending conflict boundaries
